High school students earn high school credit for Environmental Science and Leadership class.

Northwest Watershed Institute offers a 10-day (two week) **Summer Field Science Intensive Class**.

Includes daily stewardship, learning, recreation and pre-professional training.

Weekdays only. In person, outdoors. Bus provided from Port Townsend and Chimacum.

90-hour, all outdoor class — Earn .5 credit toward graduation.

July 18-22 & 25-29 - Must attend both weeks

Optional: Mentored, Pre-Professional Independent Study

During the 2022/3 school year, students who successfully complete the summer field (ESL) class have an option to design an independent 90-hour project, or series of stewardship activity projects, for an additional .5 credits.

NWI mentorship provided. Credits are through your school's **Independent Contract Credit Program**.

Service activities may include: restore streams, plant trees, conduct research, coastal clean-up, and others.

Internship: Varies depending on student interest and mentor availability.
